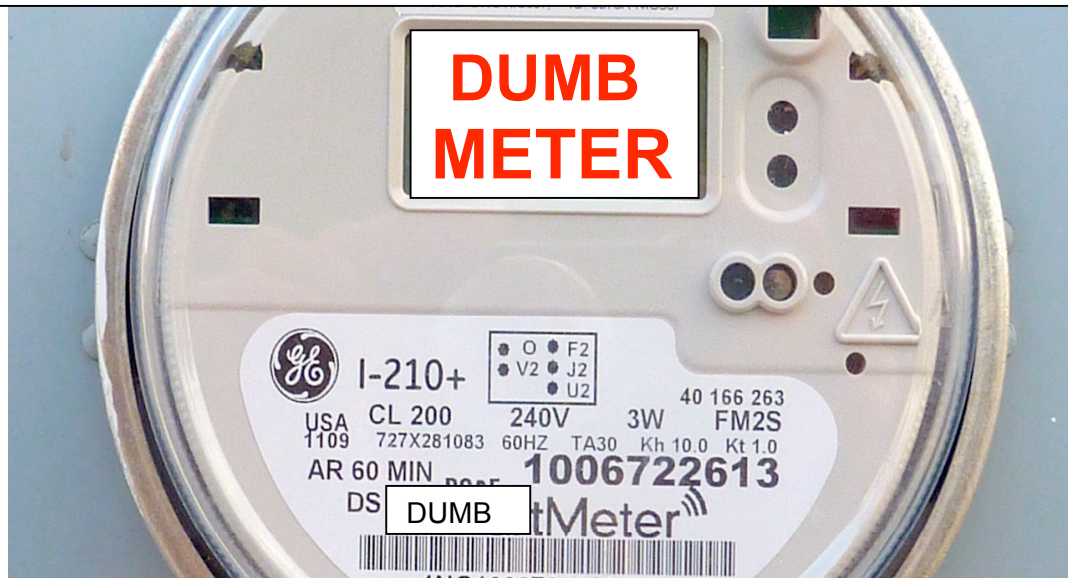


Dumb Meters are costing us money, privacy and our health and safety



People report skyrocketing utility bills, interference, burned out appliances, explosions, fires, and lack of security and privacy protection, headaches, ringing in the ears, sleep and heart problems, nausea, and other symptoms following installation. *Smart Meters constantly transmit pulsed microwave radiation, which is classified as a 2B carcinogen by the World Health Organization, same as DDT and lead.*

TAKE ACTION!

Call your gas and electric or water company. Tell them to retain or restore the analog meters at no additional cost. If you still have your analog meters, ask to be placed on the 'delay' list. All utilities are now required to delay installation upon customer request.
