

Restore the Analog Utility Meters!

*Smart Meters are costing us money,
privacy, and our health and safety.*

People report skyrocketing utility bills, interference, burned out appliances, explosions, fires, and lack of security and privacy protection, headaches, ringing in the ears, heart problems, nausea, and other symptoms following installation.

Smart Meters constantly transmit pulsed microwave radiation, which is classified as a 2B carcinogen by the World Health Organization, same as DDT and lead.

TAKE ACTION!

1. **Call your gas and electric or water company.** Tell them you want to retain or restore the analog meter at no additional cost. If you still have analog meters, ask to be on the delay list. **PG&E:** 1-877-743-7378, **SCE** 1-800-655-4555 **SDG&E** 1-800-411-7343
2. **Call or write the California Public Utilities Commission.** Demand safe and reliable utility service, retain or restore the analog meters at no additional cost and hold evidentiary hearing on microwave health impacts.
