Narrative Text	At 0127 hours on Saturday January 8, 2011 we were dispatched to excessive heat, scorch burns with no ignition. One unit was assigned to this incident. Three personnel responded. We arrived on scene at 0134 hours and cleared at 0231 hours. The incident occurred at 1086 ARLINGTON Blvd, El Cerrito in District 72A. The local station is 72. The general description of this property is 1 or 2 family dwelling. The primary task(s) performed at the scene by responding personnel was investigation. No mutual/automatic aid was given or received.

Alarm number 1100052 has been assigned to this incident.

E72 responded and arrived for a Fire Miscellaneous to an occupant standing in the front yard. Upon investigation he stated that the electrical box to the house had been sparking and damage was found on the surrounding area to the box. PG&E was requested to respond as E72 remained on scene until their arrival and the line to the home was shut down.
