The California Public Utilities Commission will evaluate PG&E's arbitrary, punitive, and likely illegal opt-out charges, and evaluate a community wide opt-out option within a couple months. You do not have to agree to PG&E's charges!

If you have a smart meter: Tell PG&E to remove it!

If you have an analog meter: Tell PG&E you plan to keep your analog meter. If they ask you to agree to the charges tell them: *"No, because the fees are arbitrary, punitive, likely illegal, and the fees are being legally contested at the CPUC."* Assert your rights. If they ask you about access to your property, tell them they need to make an appointment.

If you agree to the fees, and if they charge you, write "paid under protest" on your check and keep a copy. OR don't pay. Not paying is risk, and a form of direct action that can be helpful. However, PG&E may turn off your utilities, or install a smart meter. If this happens we can bring media attention to the issue.

Neighbors meters: *Talk to your neighbors about these choices.*
