### **NOTICE OF *EX PARTE* COMMUNICATION**

1. Pursuant to Rule 8.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, EMF Safety Network (Network) submits this Notice of *Ex Parte* Communication. The due date for the notice is Tuesday, September 14, 2010. Network will file the notice electronically on the due date.
2. Commissioner Advisor Karl Meeusen initiated a meeting with Network representatives. The meeting was held Thursday, September 9, 2010, at Commission headquarters, beginning at 1:00 pm. The meeting lasted approximately 1 hour 10 minutes. Commission staff present at the meeting were: Commissioner Advisor Carol Brown; Executive Director Paul Clanon; Division Director Matthew Deal; Mary Evans; Alope Gupta; Commissioner Advisor Sepideh Khosrowjah; Commissioner Advisor Karl Meeusen; Commissioner Advisor Paul Phillips; Commissioner Advisor Michael Wheeler; and Harold Williams. Network representatives and advisors present at the meeting were: Layna Berman; Kate Bernier; Jeffry Fawcett; Network Founder Sandi Maurer; Cindy Sage; and Melissa Weaver. Joining the meeting by phone were: Network consultant David Carpenter, MD; and Aglet Consumer Alliance Director James Weil. The *ex parte* communication was oral and by PowerPoint presentation, from Network representatives, advisors and consultant to Commissioner advisors. A paper copy of the PowerPoint presentation is attached to this notice. Network also provided to Executive Director Clanon a paper copy of the "Bioinitiative Report" mentioned in the paragraph below. 3. During the meeting: (1) Network representative Jeffry Fawcett stated that Network seeks customer choice regarding Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E)

installation of Smart Meters at customer residences and neighborhoods; (2) Fawcett stated that review of Smart Meter impacts should include review of cumulative radio frequency impacts of multiple meters; (3) Network advisor Cindy Sage asked that the Commission assist Network in production of technical data regarding radio frequency emissions from Smart Meters and associated equipment; (4) Sage described evidence on health impacts of radio frequency emissions; (5) Network representative Layna Berman discussed public concerns about Smart Meters and radio frequency emissions; (6) Network founder Sandi Maurer discussed evidence on human sensitivity to radio frequency emissions; (7) Sage described a “Bioinitiative Report” regarding health impacts of radio frequency emissions; and (8) Network consultant David Carpenter discussed cancer impacts of long-term radio frequency exposure. Network representatives and advisors answered questions from Commission staff. At the close of the meeting, Maurer requested that the Commission convene hearings on Smart Meter issues, including health impacts, security, fire hazards, privacy and other issues.
