Achievements 2019



Completed the EMF Health Effects Survey which provides insight, education and solutions for reducing EMFs. Became a party to the CPUC PG&E safety proceeding to seek justice regarding smart grid related fires. Sent a joint letter of support for AB 272 (adopted) which allows CA schools to limit cell phone use. Sent take action alerts with letter templates to protect birds, bees and people. Co-sponsored and promoted speaker events. Contacted environmental groups, and initiated a Sonoma County Stop 5G postcard campaign.

Strategic support to Fircrest Senior Mobile Home Park in Sebastopol who were threatened with a site-wide change-out to PG&E smart meters. Achieved support from the city who wrote a letter asking for no-cost analogs. All analog gas and electric meters were installed! Won Constant Contact All-Star Award for high open and click rates.

Distributed 8,400 What are EMF's brochures, plus over 10,000 other EMFSN handouts and 80 Stop 5G tote bags to activists in 18 US states, Canada and the UK. Created new Stop 5G honey bee flyer and Stop 5G fact sheet. Tabled and/or literature at: New Age Expo, Bioneers, Soil not Oil, Progressive Festival, EMF Conference, Climate Strike, Peacetown, Sonoma Strong Healing Faire and more.

EMFSN website added 17 new posts in 2019. Constant Contact added 1420 sign-ups, for a total of 4966 contacts. Facebook added 621 followers (total 2809) and Twitter added 141 followers (total 1938).

Website, email and phone support for local, state, nationwide and international groups and activists to oppose cell towers, 5G, smart meters, and to help people with EHS. Co-coordinated a flow fund grant to support the work of Americans for Safe Technology.
