



Stop FCC's Complete Takeover of Wireless Deployment

**Federal Communications Commission proposes
vast new rulemaking that will remove all local
control over wireless infrastructure.**

Local governments will be powerless, even with protective telecom ordinances.

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The FCC has proposed a sweeping rulemaking: WT Docket No. 25-276: “Build America: Eliminating Barriers to Wireless Deployments”

This rulemaking will fast-track macro towers, small cells, base stations, and antennas into our communities, overriding our ability to protect public health, aesthetics, environmental safety, and local zoning.

This is not just a technical adjustment. This may be the FCC's Rubicon — a point of no return where federal overreach replaces local democracy. Once crossed, we will lose the ability to say “No” to towers near schools, homes, parks, and historic or scenic sites.

What's at Stake:

- Loss of local permitting rights- no setbacks, no proof of RF radiation compliance
- Federal override of concealment and aesthetic protections
- Accelerated deployment timelines that silence community input
- Potential expansion of AI-driven infrastructure with no public oversight
- Our inability to stop cell sites for any reason. No due process
